The National Science Foundation has awarded Dr. Elizabeth Kutter, faculty scientist at The Evergreen State College, a \$68,000, two-year grant to fund additional genetic research.

Dr. Kutter, a biophysicist, has been conducting research on the control of gene functions with bacterial viruses for the past six years. She initially received NSF funding in 1970 while conducting her research at the University of Virginia in Charlottsville. For the past three years, her work has been supported by grants from the National Institutes of Health.

The new NSF award will provide monies for equipment maintenance, supplies, and salaries for laboratory technicians, and student researchers, in addition to part-time stipends for Dr. Kutter and fellow Evergreen faculty member Dr. Burt Guttman, a biologist who will work with her.
