Appointment of architects and engineers to begin actual design work for The Evergreen State College at Olympia will highlight a January 31 meeting of the new college's Board of Trustees at 2:00 p.m. in the Rex Room of the Olympic Hotel in Seattle.

The meeting will be held in Seattle because a gathering of the Joint Boards of Trustees of Washington's four state colleges is scheduled there the next day, explained Al E. Saunders, Board chairman of The Evergreen State College.

Engineers are expected to be named to undertake design work for roads, utilities, site improvements and the college heating plant. Architects who will design first-phase large group instruction and student activities facilities also are expected to be chosen.

In other business, the Board of Trustees will consider alterations of the master plan for site development of The Evergreen State College. The proposed changes result from continued evaluation of the plan and include a suggestion that buildings be erected in closer proximity than originally planned.

The Board also will hear a progress report about the first building to be erected on campus--a structure that initially will house library, audio-visual, classroom and office facilities when the college opens in September, 1971.
