Photography, slide/tape presentations, examples of textiles, pottery and other Mexican crafts will be on display in The Evergreen State College Library Art Gallery June 1-11.

The exhibit, entitled "Reflexiones De Meso America" is a collection by 16 Evergreen students who traveled to Mexico last Fall under the supervision of Faculty Member Susan Fiksdal. Their display offers testimony to what they saw, learned and brought home.

The three-quarter academic program sought to produce learning packages for further Evergreen Spanish language programs. So students traveled throughout the country and lived in Mexico for two quarters, studying Spanish and gathering materials through photography, journals and tapes. Their travels took them beyond the boundaries of Mexico into most of Meso America.

The travelers returned to Evergreen in April, where they have spent the past several weeks collating their materials into learning packages which are now on public display. The exhibit, coordinated by Evergreen graduating senior Lynda Weinman, is the last major exhibit in the Library Gallery until September.
