Selection of an energy source to meet heating and air conditioning requirements for The Evergreen State College is expected to be the main item of business considered when the new institution's board of trustees holds a public meeting at 3:00 p.m., Thursday, May 1. The meeting will be held in the college offices, 1020 East 5th Avenue, Olympia.

Trustees will consider fuel supply recommendations drafted by Quinton-Budlong Engineers of Seattle following a four-month study of the complicated subject. Choice of a supplier will follow a review of the consulting firm's suggestions.

If they decide in favor of a system which requires installation of a central plant, trustees probably will select a designer for the facility at the May 1 meeting.
