William T. Robinson of Olympia, a research analyst for the Washington State Senate Ways and Means Committee since December, 1973, has been named budget officer for The Evergreen State College. The appointment, announced by Evergreen Business Manager Ken Winkley, is effective March 1.

In his new post, Robinson, 27, will carry prime responsibility for directing, coordinating and preparing the college's supplemental and biennial operating and capital budget requests to the Governor's Office of Program Planning and Fiscal Management and the State Legislature.

"We're pleased to be able to employ such a well qualified person for this highly-responsible position," Winkley said in announcing the appointment. "Mr. Robinson has more than two years' experience analyzing budget requests from higher education institutions in the State of Washington, and has a thorough understanding of the budgeting processes required of state agencies. His advice should be invaluable in helping Evergreen develop budget requests and make the necessary reports to agencies to which the college is fiscally accountable."

Robinson is a U.S. Army veteran who earned his bachelor of arts degree in business administration from Washington State University in 1971.
