RE: Indian Education Program

I have called a meeting for January 7 from 12 to 1 in Library 2208 (Deans' area). The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the following agenda and the attached documents. As many of you already know the program within the Department of Education which funds the program I was preparing a grant for has been defunded, but we have decided to go ahead and initiate an Indian Education program on our own resources.
