Registration for 19 recreational and artistic workshops will begin at 10 a.m. June 23 in The Evergreen State College Recreation Center.

The workshops --- ranging in variety from beginning jewelry to wilderness travel, from tennis to beekeeping --- begin the week of July 5. Registration hours are from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays through July 2. All registration must be done in person and is on a first-come, first-served basis.

Offered Summer Quarter at Evergreen are workshops in: photo skills, beginning jewelry, pottery, beginning weaving, beginning wood working with portable tools, beginning wood working with stationary tools, jazz dance, Olympic fencing, Ki and Aikido martial arts, wilderness travel for women, wilderness travel for men and women, sailboating, self awareness and horsemanship, horsemanship and stable management, beginning beekeeping, basic scuba through open water training, advanced scuba and marine appreciation, and tennis.

Also available are open studio hours in photography, pottery and jewelry facilities, private instruction in tennis, and a special five-day wilderness trip across the Monte Cristo mountain group in the North Central Cascades. Participants who want to take the trip, scheduled for September 8-12, must have mountaineering experience.
