Drs. William C. Winden and Robert M. Knapp, faculty members at The Evergreen State College since 1972, have been named as Assistant Academic Deans, it was announced today by Vice President and Provost Edward J. Kormondy. The appointments are effective on or about September 1.

Dr. Winden, whose academic specialty is music, will serve a two-year term. Dr. Knapp, a physicist, will serve one year with an option to seek the post for an additional two years.

A student of music, Dr. Winden received his bachelor's degree from Stanford University, his master's from the University of Washington and his doctorate from the University of Illinois. He came to Evergreen from the University of Maryland, where he had served for six years as an Assistant Professor of Music. Prior to that he had taught at Southern Oregon College and had been employed as an opera and oratorio singer in Europe.

Dr. Knapp received his bachelor's degree in physics from the University of Harvard and his doctorate from Oxford University. Immediately prior to joining Evergreen, he was a lecturer at California State Polytechnic College. He also has been a research physicist and instructor at Carnegie-Mellon University in Pittsburgh and a teacher at both Harvard and Magdalen College in England.
