A new catalog of more than 320 student internships available through The Evergreen State College has been published by the institution's Office of Cooperative Education.

Evergreen Co-op Director Ken Donohue said the catalog of credit-earning on-the-job experiences includes internships from throughout the state of Washington, as well as work and study opportunities in Oregon, British Columbia, California, Kansas, Missouri, Vermont, Colorado, Illinois, New York, and Washington, D.C.

"The catalog is fairly representative of the kinds of off-campus opportunities students can participate in at Evergreen during the 1973-74 academic year," Donohue said. "New internships are developed throughout the year and we expect to have an even broader program than we were able to describe at the point of publishing our second catalog."

"We hope this publication will serve as a useful guide for both students and faculty in identifying study needs and objectives, identifying potential employers, and for planning aspects of programs which will include internships," Donohue said.

The 59-page catalog covers thirteen internship categories, including administration, management, and finance; law and political science; law enforcement and corrections; graphics, media, and public relations; education; counseling; mental health; social work; medical sciences; environmental and urban planning; science and research; arts and humanities; and miscellaneous programs in a variety of business and service organizations.
