Songstress Linda Waterfall, a strong-voiced soprano whose musical range encompasses folk, rock and blues, will return to The Evergreen State College stage May 1 for a one-night appearance beginning at 8 p.m. in the main lobby of the Evans Library Building.

Recently returned from a London recording session, Ms. Waterfall performed with the popular Entropy Service at Evergreen last year. She wrote many of the compositions performed by the local group, including "Over the Mountain," a piece they recorded on an extended playing record.

An accomplished musician, Ms. Waterfall accompanies herself on guitar and, occasionally, on piano, dulcimer or bass. The California miss has spent much of the past year performing in the Boston area on college campus, in coffeehouses and pubs.

Preceding her on stage at Evergreen will be John Carleton, Massachusetts singer/songwriter. Admission to the three-hour concert is \$1.50 at the door.
