State Senator George Fleming, Seattle Democrat, will deliver an address entitled "The Student and the Community Role in State Politics" during a February 16 appearance at The Evergreen State College. The speech, scheduled for Lecture Hall One and open to the general public, will begin at 7:30 p.m.

Fleming's appearance is sponsored by the Evergreen Chapter of Action For Washington, a non-partisan student organization.

Russell Johnson, Program Consultant of the New England American Friends Service Committee, will speak at Evergreen February 21, starting at 2:00 p.m. in Lecture Hall Five. Arrangements for his appearance are being made by the Human Development Coordinated Studies Program.

Johnson has traveled extensively in Vietnam since 1961 and also visited China in 1971, talking with many Chinese officials and speaking with Prince Sihanouk, exiled leader of Cambodia.

During his Evergreen appearance, Johnson will present "a critical analysis of present American economic and social institutions and offer an alternative view of the new society required and possible here and abroad," says Human Development student spokesman Russ Hoyt.
