"The Evolution of Photography," a slide/talk by Photographer Terry Toedtemeier, will be presented April 12 at 8 p.m. in Lecture Hall Three at The Evergreen State College. Sponsored by Evergreen Photo Services and a photography academic program, the presentation is free and open to the public.

Toedtemeier, of Portland's Blue Sky Photography Gallery, will review ways in which photo awareness has changed throughout the history of photography. His presentation will focus on the evolution of photography as an independent and unique art form. His talk and slides will cover works by Arbus, Atget, Bresson, Cummings, Erwit, Evans, Frank, Gibson, Harbutt, Koudelka, Lange, Lartigue, Lee, Model, Philips, Rexroth, Shahn, Weegee, Windgrand, and others.

An accomplished photographer and lecturer, Toedtemeier has recently organized a display collection of 19th century photographs for the Oregon Museum of Science and Industry. A portion of his collection will be exhibited in the Evergreen Library Mini Media Production Center (room 1302 and 1341) April 12 and 13. Toedtemeier will be available to discuss the images and the photographers who created them April 13 from 9 to 11 a.m. in the Mini Center.
