Long registration lines and complicated procedures are a regular part of the beginning of classes on campuses across the nation every quarter, but not for students at The Evergreen State College, who will be able to complete their registration for the entire year next week. And they can do it by mail.

Evergreen Registrar, Perrin Smith, said more than 2,000 registration packets will be mailed to fall quarter students August 18 and must be returned by September 1.

"All students will have to do is sign their program selection cards and return them with checks covering their tuition to complete registration for fall quarter," Smith said. "All students have to do for winter and spring quarters is pay their fees."

The new registration program is possible at Evergreen because, as Smith explained, "most of our students are assigned to one continuing program for the year. For 80 per cent of them, no changes in registration will be necessary until next fall."

For those who do want to change their programs, an alternate registration procedure has been worked out through Evergreen's academic deans.

Students who fail to return their packets by September 1 will be dropped from Evergreen's enrollment and the college will begin to draw on its student waiting list, Smith said.
