## Chair's opening remarks

#### **Public Comment**

Trustee David Nicandri moved to delegate authority to the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees working with the Karras Consulting firm, to develop a proposed interim administrative structure and bring recommendations back to the full board within 10 days. The motion was seconded by Trustee Monica Alexander and passed on a voice vote.
