The joint venture of Quinton-Budlong of Seattle and Eckbo, Dean,

Austin and Williams of San Francisco has been named by The Evergreen State

College's board of trustees to handle landscape design work for the first

phase of construction at the new institution.

Action on the appointment was taken at an April 12 board meeting in Olympia.

Wayne Florian of Seattle and Ed Williams of San Francisco will be the two firms' representatives on the college design team, headed by architect Robert Durham of Seattle. Members of the team include persons from architectural firms previously chosen to design buildings for the college's first-phase construction.

In another action, the board of trustees directed Durham, Anderson and Freed architects of Seattle to complete design development drawings for the college library and proceed to working drawings, subject to approval of the State Division of Engineering and Architecture and the college staff.

It is anticipated the working drawings will be completed in time for an October bid call for construction of the 337,453 square-foot library building.

In a final action, trustees set May 1 as the date for the next board meeting. It will be held at the college offices, 1020 East 5th Avenue, Olympia.
