Winter Quarter registration for academic work at The Evergreen State College, Olympia, begins December 8 and concludes December 17, it was announced today by Registrar Perrin Smith. The deadline for payment of Winter Quarter tuition and fees is January 10.

The registration process begins with a mass mailing of packets to all presently-enrolled students. The packets contain a program selection card already signed by the appropriate faculty coordinator and a student information audit, which includes a computer print-out of personal information already on file.

To register, students merely sign and date the front side and fill out the reverse side of the program selection card; sign and update the information audit, if necessary; and return the two items in person to the registrar's office not later than December 17.

Bills for tuition and fees will be mailed to all students by the Student Accounts Office on December 31, with payments due ten days later.

"Evergreen's first registration, held last September, was carried out entirely by mail", Smith said. "We're modifying that procedure slightly by having students return the registration materials in person, but the registration act is still easy and quick and there will be no standing in long lines for anyone."

The new college's Fall Quarter enrollment in the first year of instruction totaled 1178, including full-time and part-time students.
