Robert W. Corrigan, who served a four-year term as the first president of the California Institute of the Arts, will discuss "Art and Technology: An Anxious Relationship," January 29 at 2:30 p.m. in Lecture Hall Five of The Evergreen State College.

Author of more than one hundred articles on theater, literature, education and the arts, Corrigan has published, edited or translated nearly 20 books in the past 11 years.

Corrigan, a former dean of the Schools of the Arts of New York University, received his doctorate from the University of Minnesota in 1955, obtained a master's degree from John Hopkins University in 1952, and completed his bachelor's degree at Cornell University in 1950. He has taught at Bennington College, Carnegie-Mellon University, the University of Southern California at Los Angeles and Tulane University.

His talk is free and the public is invited.
