Modern jazz and rock bands, African music and contemporary poetry are all slated for an eight-hour "Save the Children" benefit at The Evergreen State College Sunday (Feb. 22) from 4 p.m. to midnight on the fourth floor of the Evans Library Building.

Organized by Evergreen students Paul Siskind of New York City and Jim Doney of Seattle, the eight-hour musical program is designed to raise money for the young victims of the Guatemala earthquake. All proceeds from the \$2-per-person admission will go to the Save the Children Federation in Guatemala.

Bands on tap for the event include the New Blue Devils, the Terremoto Relief Band, the Psalms of Pharaoh, Conch, and Air Brush. Olympia pianists Jack Percival and John Grace are also lined up, along with Evergreen Faculty Musician Dumi Maraire on the mbira, Evergreen student poet Eluage Anthony, and a synchronized slide/music show entitled "Interactions."

Food will be catered by the Rainbow Deli. The event is open to the public, and its Evergreen sponsors hope residents from throughout Thurston County will attend.
