A baroque concert, featuring two Spokane performers on oboe and harpsichord will be offered January 29, beginning at noon in the main lobby of The Evergreen State College Library Building.

The Spokane twosome, known as "La Galliade Duo," is composed of David Dutton, a Washington State University oboe instructor, and Beverly Biggs, a harpsichordist for the Spokane Symphony and the Spokane Baroque Consort.

The free, public concert, sponsored by the newly created Evergreen Muse, will include music by composers Telemann, Bach, Schiekhardt, Balbastre and LaVigne, and will be followed by a 3 p.m. informal workshop on baroque oboe and harpsichord. The workshop, which is also open to the public, will include explanation of the instruments and demonstrations of ornamentation techniques. Both Dutton and Ms. Biggs will also be available from 1 to 3 p.m. to answer questions.

The Evergreen Muse, a combination of Evergreen's new chamber music module and performing society, is co-directed by Faculty musicians Robert Gottlieb and Greg Steinke, and will sponsor a number of noon concerts featuring both on-campus and guest performers Winter and Spring Quarters.
