


# EVERGREEN



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### LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER

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The Learning Resource Center is available to any TESC student who wishes individual help with reading, writing, or study skills. Such assistance includes:

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### UPWARD BOUND

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Upward Bound helps students complete high school and continue their education. For low-income students in their second year of high school (grades 10-11).

Services - A six (6) week summer school on the campus, followed by tutoring and career counseling during the academic year.

Internships for Evergreen Students - Tutor/Counselor positions in Upward Bound are excellent opportunities to get hands-on experience in education and counseling. All positions are paid and administrative staff will subcontract for a limited number of interns, working in Thurston County and Tacoma, during the academic year.
