SUBJECT: Third World American Scholarship

As per our community meeting on May 20, 1982, concerning the Third World American Foundation scholarships, community members present agreed on the following.

Definition of Merit

Merit will be signified by an individual's contributions to his/her community, and/or demonstrated talents in such areas as art, science, drama, journalism, music, athletics, etc. Academic achievements will be concerned but will not be a primary indicator.

Eligible Recipients

Any new (first time attending Evergreen) Third World student accepted for full-time enrollment into the College.

Application Materials

Applicants will forward a letter of application, three letters of recommendation, application for admissions and official copies of previous academic background.

Application Deadline and Award Date

Applications will be received until July 15, 1982, with letters of disposition being sent to students by August 1, 1982.

The only unfinished business was that of forming a Screening Committee whose function will be to read applications and select the awardees. I know these responsibilities come during the summer months, however, your support is needed and will be greatly appreciated. We need four people (representative from each community).
