Folk dances from several foreign countries will be presented in a 20-minute concert in the Mondays at Eight series January 22 at 8 p.m. in the reference alcove of The Evergreen State College.

The concert, featuring some 20 Evergreen students, will be presented in conjunction with a folk dance workshop under the direction of Dina Hartzell, a former Oregonian now studying at Evergreen who has participated in numerous workshops throughout Oregon, Washington and California.

Ms. Hartzell, who organized and now teaches a bi-weekly folk dance activity at the college, has also taught at the Catlin Gabel High School, Portland, and at the University of Oregon. The 20-year-old dancer has studied under more than 20 dance instructors and is presented by Eye-5, an organization supported by the National Endowment for the Arts. Both the concert and the workshop are free and open to the public.
