Larry R. Stenberg, Director of Admissions at University of Puget Sound in Tacoma since 1965, has been named Director of Counseling Services for The Evergreen State College at Olympia, effective August 1, it was announced today by Executive Vice President E. J. Shoben, Jr.

"Mr. Stenberg's duties will include the organization and leadership of Evergreen's career counseling and its services to members of the college community, particularly students, who encounter emotional or developmental problems," Shoben said. "A major goal of the Counseling Service will be to maintain a close check on the ways that the institution affects its people, thus permitting the college to modify its own procedures and practices to insure a more effective environment for learning."

Stenberg, 31 and a 1957 graduate of Stadium High School in Tacoma, received bachelor of arts and master's degrees in education from University of Puget Sound in 1961 and 1963 respectively.

He served as Coordinator of Student Activities at UPS from 1960 to 1962, was named Dean of Men in 1962 and became Director of Admissions in 1965. He also was Inter-Fraternity Council Advisor and Yearbook Advisor from 1962 through 1969.

Stenberg has been a member of the Executive Council of Pacific Northwest Admissions Counselors; Western Regional Representative for the National Scholarship and Service Fund for Negro students; Executive Board of the Washington State Council on High School-College Relations; College Conference Commission and Educational Continuity Commission, and College Board Western Regional Executive Committee on School and College Relations.
