Sixteen students from The Evergreen State College at Olympia are fanning out across the country this week to begin their internships in the initial effort of the newly-formed Student Vote organization.

Student Vote, a non-partisan organization headquartered in Washington, D.C., is a nationwide program in which interns are placed in the field to organize and direct voter registration drives in all 50 states during the Winter and Spring college terms.

Evergreen students, selected for the internships late in December through the college's Office of Cooperative Education, underwent an intensive three-day training seminar January 10-12, after which they received their internship assignments. The seminar, held at Evergreen, familiarized the students with organizational methods and procedures, election laws of the states they will visit, and skills necessary to their development as effective interns.

All participants in the program will receive full academic work for their approximately three-month voter registration activities.
