The Office of Cooperative Education at The Evergreen State College has received a \$28,333 grant from the Region Ten Office of the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration to sponsor research internships with agencies that deal with criminal justice.

Ken Donohue, Director of Evergreen's Co-Op Education program, said the grant is the only one awarded in Region Ten this year. Evergreen was selected, LEAA officials told Donohue, because of its flexible internship program because of the ability Evergreen students have demonstrated in their internship projects.

Donohue said the college has placed more than 2,300 students in credit-generating internships in a wide variety of business, educational, social service, and governmental agencies since the program first began in 1971.
