THE THIRD WORLD BICENTENNIAL IS GOING TO HAPPEN AROUND THE LAST WEEK OF APRIL. THIS IS A PROPOSAL DRAWN UP BY STUDENTS WORKING ON THE FORUM FOR AN ACADEMIC CONTRACT EVOLVING AROUND THE ORGANIZING ACTIVITIES OF THE FORUM.

FOR THIS SYMPOSIUM TO BE A REAL LEARNING EXPERIENCE WE PLAN TO BREAKDOWN THE GROUP INTO WORKING COMMITTEES OR CORE GROUPS, TIGHT UNITS OF STUDENTS DEDICATED TO ALL THE HARD AND TEDIOUS DETAILS THAT MUST BE WORKED OUT IN ORDER TO HAVE THE FORUM FUNCTION SMOOTHLY. THESE CORE GROUPS WILL BE UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF A FACULTY MEMBER WORKING PART-TIME SPECIFICALLY ON ONE AREA OF ORGANIZATION AND RESPONSIBLE FOR THOSE STUDENTS LEARNING IN THE DEFINED AREA. IF NO FACULTY ARE AVAILABLE TO FILL THE ROLE, THEN OUTSIDE CONSULTANTS WOULD HAVE TO BE HIRED. THE BASIC AREAS OF ORGANIZATION WOULD BE CLASSIFIED UNDER:

THOUGH SOME FUNCTIONS MAY OVERLAP OTHERS WE FEEL THAT THIS WILL BE A SMALL ENOUGH GROUP TO MAINTAIN COMMUNICATION BETWEEN FATIONS.

FACULTY POSITIONS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE SPECIFIC AREAS OF ORGANIZATION. IT IS OUR DESIRE TO MAKE THE FORUM AN EXPRESSION OF THE PEOPLE PLANNED BY THE PEOPLE WHICH MEANS FACILITATING A COMMUNICATION SYSTEM TO ITS MAXIMUM USAGE. FOR INSTANCE IF A GROUP IS FORMED WHICH TAKES ON THE TASK OF PRODUCING A DOCUMENTARY ON THE FORUM WE'D NEED A PERSON TO SHOW US HOW TO BRING ABOUT THAT GOAL. IF AN EVERGREEN FACULTY MEMBER CHOSE NOT TO WORK WITH THE FORM, AN OUTSIDE FACULTY WOULD HAVE TO BE CHOSEN.

THE FORUM COMMITTEE HAS BEEN WORKING SINCE JULY AND IS ENTHUSIASTIC AND OPTIMISTIC THAT EVERGREEN SHOULD BE THE CENTER OF ALL THIS AND THAT STUDENTS ARE INVOLVED IN ITS PLANNING.

WE ARE LOOKING FOR ABOUT 10-15 STUDENTS FOR THE CONTRACT EACH WITH THEIR OWN SPECIAL INTEREST AREA AND A WILLINGNESS TO CO-ORDINATE OTHERS. THE FORUM CONTRACT WILL BE A WORKING ONE, LOTS OF HARD WORK AND WE CAN PROMISE LONG HOURS LITTLE THANKS AND MANY HASSLES. BUT THE REWARD WILL BE THE INDIVIDUAL'S PERSONAL SATISFACTION IN DOING SOMETHING TO HELP THIRD WORLD PEOPLE. POTENTIAL STUDENTS SHOULD COME WITH AN OPEN MIND AND THE ABILITY TO THINK. THE STAGING OF THE FORUM WILL BE A DESIGN PROBLEM. SINCE THIS WILL BE AN EVENT LIKE NO OTHER IT IS STRONGLY SUGGESTED THAT ONLY THE DEDICATED, CREATIVE, HARD-WORKERS JOIN THE TEAM.

SOME OF THE FORUM ACTIVITIES ARE :

- A NATIONAL BICENTENNIAL POSTER CONTEST
- A NATIONAL BICENTENNIAL MURAL PAINTING COMPETITION
- A LITERARY ANTHOLOGY OF THE WRITTEN ARTS
- A FEATURE LENGTH VIDEO TAPE OR FILM
- RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT OF A "THIRD WORLD PHILOSOPHY"
- FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES AND HAPPENINGS

FORUM WORKERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO CARRY ON WITH OTHER ACTIVITIES SO NOT TO CREATE THE TENSION AND PRESSURE OF ROUTINES. ALREADY WE'VE MANAGED TO FEEL WHAT STRESS IS WHILE WORKING ON ONE SPECIFIC FUNCTION. IT IS BRAIN-DRAINING WORK. WE PLAN TO INTEGRATE ARTISTIC ACTIVITIES (FILM, VIDEO, THEATRE & DANCE, PRINTMAKING WORKSHOPS) IN ORDER TO COMBINE OUR POLITICAL HACK WORK WITH HUMAN EXPRESSION AND CREATION.

STUDENT INTERESTED IN WORKING ON THE FORUM PART-TIME IN CONJUNCTION WITH OTHER RELATED PROGRAMS ARE WELCOME. PARTIAL CREDIT SHOULD BE AVAILABLE.

THE ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTION WILL BE SERVED BY THE STEERING COMMITTEE, MADE UP OF REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL THE THIRD WORLD FACTIONS ON CAMPUS. THE FORUM ADVISORY BOARD WILL PROVIDE INSTITUTIONAL DIRECTION AND EVALUATION. THE GROUP WILL BE ~~BEING~~ DIVIDED INTO WORKING (TASK FORCE) UNITS - TIGHT COHESIVE GROUPS - DESIGNING PARTICULAR AREAS OF ORGANIZATION.

EVALUATION WILL BE NOTED BY:

- ① PROGRESS OF FORUM PLAN
- ② THE ACQUISITION OF NEW SKILLS
- ③ COMMUNITY REACTION TO FORUM PLANNING
- ④ STUDENT/FACULTY CONFERENCES

OUR BASIC AIM IS EDUCATIONAL, BOTH FOR THOSE WHO ATTEND AND TO THOSE OF US HERE, AWAY AT EVERGREEN, WHO HAVE NOT EXPERIENCED THIRD WORLD PEOPLES EN MASS AND ALL HAVING IN COMMON THE HOPE FOR HUMANITY TO LIVE TOGETHER; AND FOR US, THIRD WORLD PEOPLE WITH THE FUTURE RAPIDLY FALLING UPON OUR HANDS. WE WISH TO LEARN THE POLITICS AND PRESSURES OF STAGING SUCH AN EVENT. ALREADY WE KNOW THE ODDS AGAINST US ARE LARGE. OUR WORST ENEMIES ARE TIME AND BUREAUCRACIES.

SO IT IS NOW TIME TO COMBINE OUR SKILLS AND RESOURCES AND CONCENTRATE OUR ENERGIES INTO A WHOLE GOAL. THERE IS SO LITTLE TIME LEFT AND MUCH TO DO.
