Prospective students, their parents, high school and college teachers, principals and counselors, and members of the general public in Thurston, Mason, Lewis and Grays Harbor Counties are invited to attend a special get-acquainted session with representatives of The Evergreen State College April 17 in room E110 of the College Activities Building. The program, entitled "The Evergreen State College Preview", will begin at 7:30 p.m.

The preview, sponsored by Evergreen's Office of Admissions, is part of a continuing effort to take Evergreen to the people in various areas of Washington, according to Director of Admissions Ken Mayer.

Evergreen representatives will include admissions personnel, faculty members, students, financial aid officers, and student services personnel.

"Our basic idea is to share information about Evergreen's philosophy, current and future programs, and such services as financial aid, placement, Cooperative Education internships, counseling, veterans affairs and admissions procedures," Mayer said. "The meeting will be informal and there will be ample time for everyone to have questions answered concerning all aspects of study and campus life at Evergreen."
