left: Dancers form a circle so that their classmates can showcase moves.

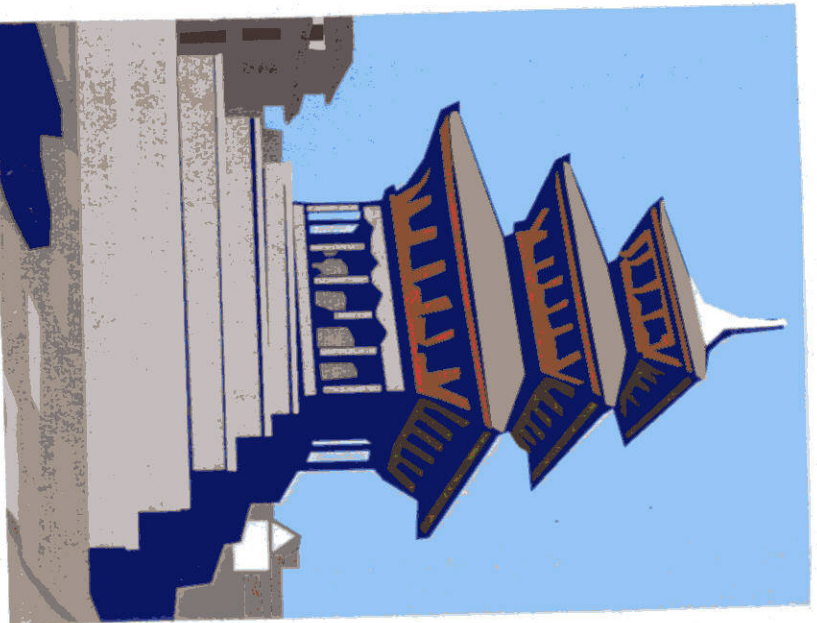
below: The class practices exciting "freezes," a common ending in a breakdance routine.

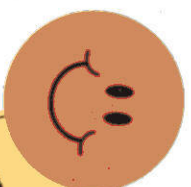

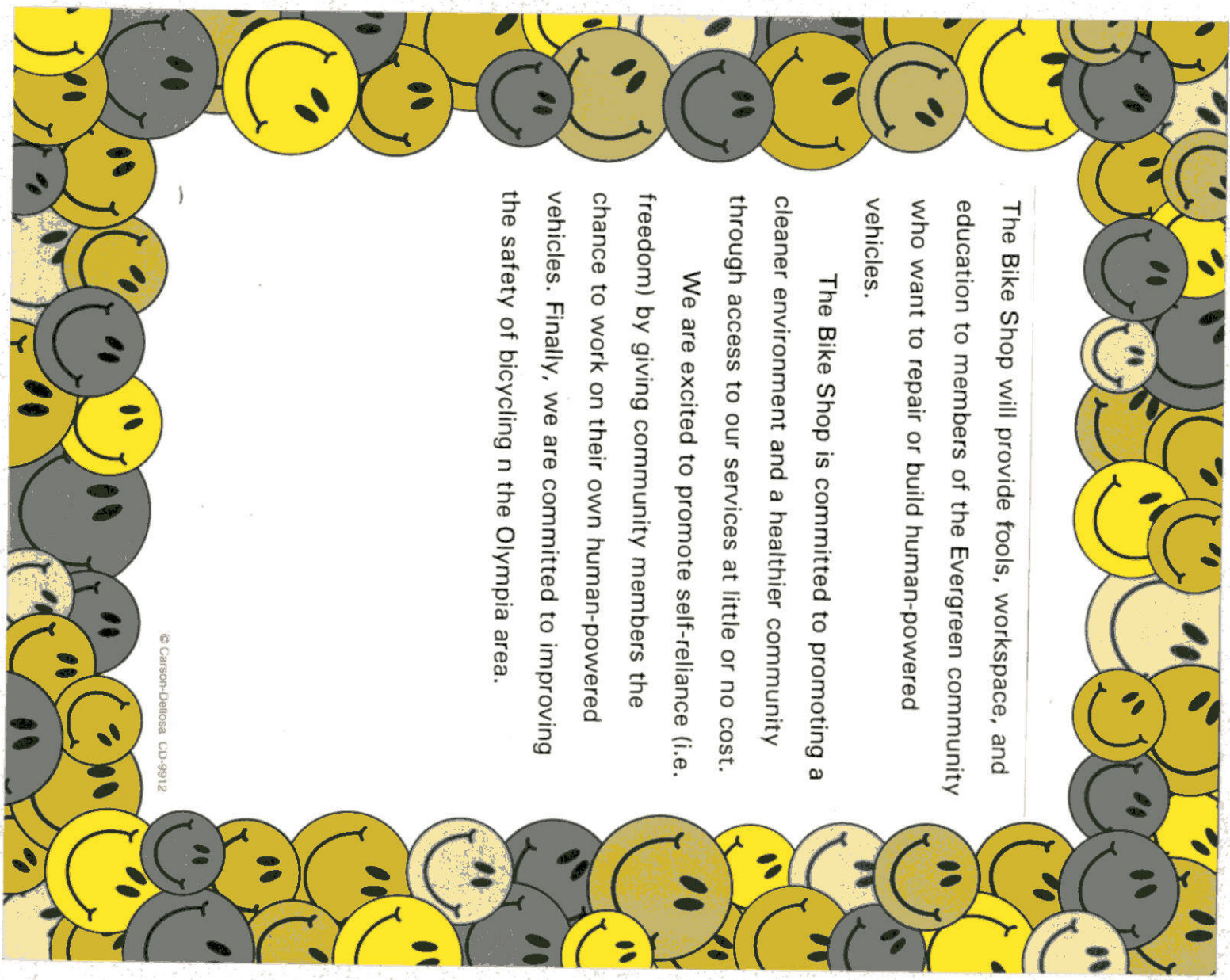


The Bike Shop

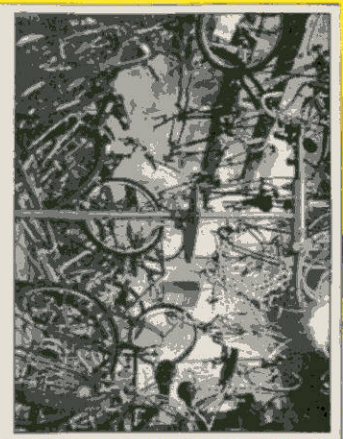

The Evergreen Bike Shop is sponsoring two free workshops hosted by volunteer Ben Tabor on the following days:

- *Monday, May 13, 5-7 p.m. Hubs, Headsets, and Bottom Brackets*

The Bike Shop is a student-run space where everyone is welcome to come in at any time and work on, or learn how to work on, their bike. You'll find all the tools you need, as well as a horde of spare parts and even entire bikes available for whatever donation you see fit. We also sell some new parts. Membership cost is \$4 per quarter for students or a \$1 daily membership, and nobody is ever turned away. The Evergreen Bike Shop staff are volunteers and are here to help you.
