

THE EVERGREEN STATE COLLEGE

The cluster of temporary buildings on the campus of The Evergreen State College has expanded again with the addition of another trailer house to provide office space for the institution's academic planners.

The triple-sized trailer--measuring 30 by 52 feet when fully assembled--is the fourth such facility placed on the college campus, northwest of Olympia. One trailer is occupied by facilities planning personnel, another contains the staff of the controller and a third serves as a library services and conference facility.

Other college offices are located in a nearby remodeled building that once housed a custom meat cutting operation.

The new trailer will provide office space for the college's Vice President and Provost; Deans of the Divisions of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, Social Sciences and Humanities and Arts; and clerical personnel to serve them.

Other temporary facilities will be moved to the campus during the next year as required by staff growth and will be utilized until office space is ready in the college library, scheduled for completion in August, 1971, about one month ahead of the start of classes. Work on the library will begin soon.
