Approval of schematic drawings which will be submitted with an application for approximately \$2.6 million in federal funds to assist with construction of the first building at The Evergreen State College tops the agenda for the December 12 meeting of the new college's Board of Trustees in Olympia.

The meeting will start at nine a.m. at the college offices, 1020 East Fifth Avenue, according to Board Chairman A.E. Saunders of Tacoma.

The application for Higher Education Facilities Act funds is due December 13 in the Olympia offices of the Higher Education Facilities Commission.

In addition to reviewing schematic drawings for the application, the Board of Trustees also is expected to discuss general design concepts for the library-multi-purpose building.

Also listed on the agenda of the monthly board meeting is execution of a contract to enable the Seattle consulting team of Durham, Anderson and Freed, Architects and Quinton Engineers to proceed with the final phase of planning and design standards studies.
