A backwards journey in time to a magnificent civilization of yesteryear awaits the armchair traveler attending Dr. Donald G. Humphrey's presentation of "The Lost (and Found) World of the Quintana Roo: A Visit to Maya Land", scheduled February 18 at The Evergreen State College.

Part of a Winter and Spring Quarter "Wednesday Evening Lecture Series", the program is open to the public free of charge and will begin promptly at 8:00 p.m. in Auditorium One of Evergreen's Lecture Halls Building.

The presentation features a slide-tape adventure to the little-explored Yucatan territory of Quintana Roo to discover the lost cities of the Maya. The illustrated talk combines the results of four expeditions to the Yucatan--the most recent being January of this year.

Dr. Humphrey, a biologist, has traveled extensively--including several research expeditions to South and Central America--and is an accomplished photographer. His Quintana Roo presentation blends colorful slides with an informative narrative about a bygone and brilliant chapter in the history of mankind.

Initially employed as an academic dean in 1970, Dr. Humphrey helped coordinate general academic planning and played a leading role in developing Evergreen's physical facilities for the sciences and arts. After serving as a dean, he became a full-time faculty member.

Dr. Humphrey was a Professor of Biology and Assistant Dean of Faculty at Oregon State University prior to joining Evergreen. He also has taught at the University of Washington and Oregon College of Education and served one year as a Research Associate and Visiting Scholar at Harvard University.

A zoology major, he received his bachelor's degree from State University of Iowa, his master's at the University of Washington, and his doctorate at Oregon State University. He also has been a National Science Foundation Faculty Fellow at Harvard.
